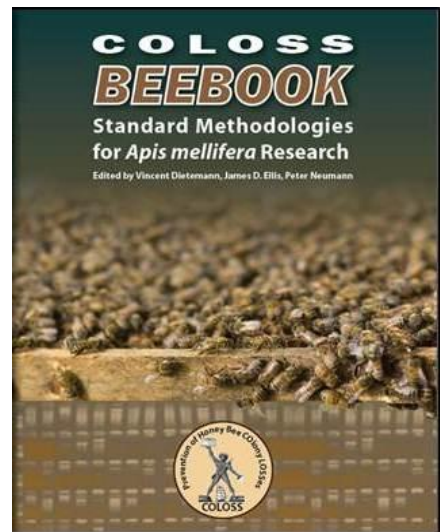


# The BEEBOOK is here!
